Woven Hug 2.0 is an innovative participatory project led by Latin American textile artists Tere Chad and Cordelia Rizzo, where recycled materials will be used to create a wonderful textile artwork, or 'hug', which will then be embellished with designs and embroidered pieces created by community groups and residents during a series of workshops at Flowerfield. These pieces will reflect on various topics that including Northern Ireland society post-Good Friday Agreement, the textile heritage of the region, the historical role of women in society, our beautiful landscapes, and the impact of climate change upon them. This project draws inspiration from Chilean arpilleras from the Conflict Textiles Collection.

The finished piece will be two arms extending from the first-floor façade of Flowerfield Arts Centre in a welcoming hug that will be displayed throughout July and August.
