Roberta will discuss the current RCC exhibition 'From Displacement to Empowerment,' her work with Conflict Textiles, including her major exhibition currently running at the Ulster Museum, and her fascinating career to date.

Roberta Bacic, born in Chile and a resident of Northern Ireland, is the founder of Conflict Textiles, an internationally significant collection of arpilleras. She holds degrees in philosophy and English teaching and works as a researcher in fields related to human rights. She was a professor at the Austral University of Chile (1973-1981), worked in various institutes and schools, and contributed to the National Corporation of Reparation and Reconciliation, the successor to the Truth Commission in Chile. From 1998 to 2002, she served as a Program and **Development Officer for War Resisters**
