COAL SUPPLIES

THE ULSTER WORKERS' COUNCIL HAVE ARRANGED TO OBTAIN COAL SUPPLIES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS BUT TO DATE THE ARMY WILL NOT ALLOW THE SUPPLIES TO BE DRAWN OUT OF THE PRE-PACK COAL STATION IN THE HARBOUR ESTATE.

WE ASK THE ARMY TO RECONSIDER THEIR POLICY SO THAT THE SENIOR CITIZENS CAN BE SUPPLIED.

WATER SUPPLIES

THE PUBLIC ARE ADVISED TO GET IN TOUCH WITH THE WATER COMMISSIONERS TO ASCERTAIN WHETHER THE WATER IN THEIR AREA SHOULD BE BOILED BEFORE.

SEWERAGE SYSTEM

THE COUNCIL WOULD ASK WORKERS TO CONTINUE WITH THIS ESSENTIAL SERVICE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

ANIMAL FEED

LAST SUPPLIES ARE BEING DELIVERED BY THE WORKERS' COUNCIL. THE ARMY ARE EXPECTED TO TAKE UP THESE DUTIES AS FROM MIDNIGHT.

TRANSPORT AND DELIVERY OF MEDICAL SERVICES

THE COUNCIL FEEL THAT THIS WOULD BE A MATTER FOR THE MILITARY AUTHORITIES AS FROM TUESDAY NIGHT MIDNIGHT.

MILK SUPPLIES

THE MILK SHOULD BE BOTTLED AND DELIVERED TODAY AS AND FROM MIDNIGHT THE SUPPLY OF MILK WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MILITARY.

BREAD SUPPLIES

BREAD WILL BE BAKED AND DELIVERED TODAY BUT AS FROM MIDNIGHT THE ARMY WILL TAKE ON THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR BAKING AND DELIVERING ~~THE~~ BREAD.
